COVID-19 SHOW GUIDELINES

A great deal of thought and consideration has been put into place to ensure the best for our attendees, vendors and staff. We are looking forward to a safe and comfortable wedding planning experience for everyone. We encourage everyone to practice social distancing, wear a mask and obey the following guidelines, so we can all enjoy the event together. Please help us by exercising patience upon arrival, following the direction of our staff and respecting everyone's desire to stay safe.

We will be following all TX & CDC Guidelines for retail establishments. Attendance will be monitored to comply with occupancy mandates.

LET'S BE SAFE TOGETHER

- Wearing face coverings by show staff, participating wedding vendors and attendees will be required in compliance with the TX mandate.

We encourage all attendees to have their own face coverings.

- Stay at home if you have been in contact with someone who has shown symptoms or has been exposed to a person who has tested positive for COVID-19.
- We will make every effort to ensure safety.
 1. Space around vendor booths will be increased.
 2. Six feet of social distance between yourself and other attendees should be maintained.
 3. Aisles will be wider.
 4. Hand sanitizer will be available.
 5. Increased disinfection and cleaning of public areas will be maintained.
- Food & Beverage samples:
 1. Pre-packaged for individual handling and consumption.
 2. Plated and served to the customer by the vendor.
 3. Attendees are not permitted to self-serve food or beverage.
- Admission Tickets
 1. Advanced, online ticket registration is encouraged as it will allow contactless ticket scans. You can register in advance from our website.
 2. You must bring a device capable of displaying your show ticket(s) and QR code.
 3. If you purchase a multi-ticket pack, all guidelines, terms & conditions and release & waiver of liability apply to each attendee.

4. We suggest you screenshot your ticket for easy access versus retrieving from email using WIFI.
